

Neighbourhood Wardens Excellence Award Scheme

Stage 1 - Registration 'Committed to Excellence'

Total cost £500

Before being assessed against the standard an applicant organisation must first register. Registration lasts for a period of 12 months and gives the applicant membership to Investors in Excellence along with a plaque and certificate.

Diagnostic Workshop (optional)

Total cost £600

The Neighbourhood Wardens Excellence Awards diagnostic workshops are run over a half day by experienced Investors in Excellence Assessors. The assessors are able to provide dedicated advice and support to the applicant organisation of up to a maximum of 12 attendees. Diagnostic Workshops are available at stage 2, 3 and 4 of the award programme.

Stage 2 - 'Working Towards Excellence'

Total cost £600

This stage of the Neighbourhood Wardens Excellence Award will be carried out by a qualified Investors in Excellence Assessor. This will include a desk top assessment of an applicant organisations workbook, site visit and feedback report. Successful applicants will receive a 'Working Towards Excellence' Certificate.

Stage 3 - 'Achieving Warden Excellence'

Total cost £600

Please see stage 2 above. Successful applicants will receive an 'Achieving Warden Excellence' certificate.

Stage 4 - 'Investors in Excellence'

Total cost £1,900

Please see stages above. Successful applicants will receive an 'Investors in Excellence' plaque and certificate.

Additional Costs

Diagnostic workshops and site visits are subject to additional charges for travel and subsistence of Investors in Excellence Assessors. All additional charges where they exist will be agreed with applicant organisation prior to visits taking place.

Additional charges will be made to re-assess applicant organisations who fail to meet the award standards. All charges will be agreed with applicant organisations before re-assessments take place.
